

## **USED PACKAGING ACCEPTANCE CONDITIONS**

**The collection and receipt of used packaging must be in compliance with the following conditions:**

1. The responsibility for correct consignment remains with the Supplier / Producer of the Goods and/or Waste Products.
2. For the purposes of clarity; “Empty” means; “that all reasonable efforts have been made to remove any left-over contents from the container. This may involve for example physical or mechanical means such as draining or scraping. The method of emptying will depend upon the container and the substances involved.”
3. Each and every container must be clearly labelled or marked to indicate the true product contained and must comply fully with all applicable regulations for marking of hazardous products.
4. All packaging must be loaded upright on the vehicle with all correct closures securely fitted to prevent leakage during transport.
5. Packagings containing Acutely Hazardous or Red Listed materials must not be consigned without prior written approval from a WasteCare Senior Manager or Director.
6. All packagings must be in a suitable condition for manual handling by WasteCare staff – ie; no product residues / contamination on the outer surfaces.
7. Any Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) and REACH information must be made available to WasteCare immediately upon request.
8. All consignments are received on the basis that the Supplier / Producer agrees to accept the assessment of the consignment by Wastecare and any associated charges at the rates as agreed.
9. Charges levied in accordance with the assessment for each consignment and the agreed rates will be paid by the Supplier / Producer in accordance with the WasteCare Credit Terms as stated on the invoice.
10. WasteCare reserves the right at all times to refuse carriage or acceptance of any items and may return any goods or wastes on the grounds of Health & Safety and Waste Management / Treatment considerations.
